# GENERAL INFO

**> OUR MISSION** Covenant Pines, a ministry of the Twin City Covenant Churches, exists to reach people of all ages with the Gospel message of Jesus Christ through an experience in a Christian environment located in a natural setting.

**> REGISTRATION** Register online at [www.covenantpines.org](http://www.covenantpines.org), or complete the registration form on page 18 and mail or fax it to the camp office. The registration form can also be given to the camp representative at a Twin Cities Covenant Church. A full payment or minimum deposit of \$75 is required to reserve a place in the requested camp. Payment in full is required one week prior to the start of camp. We accept Visa, Mastercard and Discover. Registrations are not transferable and deposits are nonrefundable.

**> CANCELLATIONS** In the event a summer registration is cancelled, you will receive a refund of paid fees less the \$75 nonrefundable deposit. No refunds will be issued for cancellations within 7 days of a summer camp/retreat date.

**> TRANSPORTATION** Bus transportation costs are included for all Kids Kamps, Pathfinders, Trailblazers, Jr. High and Sr. High camps. Arrive at the bus stop 15 minutes prior to departure and arrival times. Parents may bring children to camp; however, campers are not allowed to drive a car to camp. Please clearly mark all luggage and bedding/sleeping bags. This year all camps, except June Senior High, begin at 12:30 pm on the first day. June Senior High begins at 4:00 pm. Camps end with a lunch meal and buses depart from camp at 1:00. Signatures from an authorized parent or guardian are required when picking children up at camp or at the bus stop (except for Senior High).

**> HEALTH/INSURANCE** Covenant Pines has a nurse on staff to care for minor problems. A doctor and clinic are minutes away. All claims for sickness and injury will be submitted to parents. Please clearly mark all medications being sent to camp and keep all prescriptions in their original containers.

**> CABIN PALS** In order to be placed with a friend of your choice, both camper and friend must request each other as cabin pals. Please register for no more than two cabin pals. Each camper will find out his/her cabin assignments after arrival at camp. There is no guarantee that clusters of friends will be placed together in cabins.

**> HEALTH FORM** State laws require an immunization record, with diseases indicated on the Health History Form (page 16), be reviewed by a doctor or nurse within 90 days before the start of camp session. If the health history identifies health problems or activity limitations, a physical examination must be performed by a licensed physician. All campers must turn in a signed Health History Form before boarding the bus.

**> ACTIVITIES AT COVENANT PINES** At Covenant Pines, campers can participate in many fun and exciting activities including: archery, boating, bouldering wall, Bible study, camp fires, camping out, canoeing, carpet ball, chapel, climbing tower, crafts, disc golf, fishing, foosball, gaga ball, group games, gymnasium, hayrides, hiking, human foosball, hydrobiking, ping-pong, Red Shark, rope swing, sailing, skills classes, sling-shot range, swimming, team building, team sports, The Blob, The Iceberg, volleyball, water polo, water skiing, waterslide, water tubing, worship, zip line and more!

**> QUESTIONS** All campers will receive a confirmation packet with detailed information before his/her camp week. A "What to Bring List" is included in the confirmation packet as well as posted on our website. # LEADERSHIP + SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

Covenant Pines offers four summer programs for high school students to develop greater leadership skills, strengthen their faith, and serve God and others. *An application is required for each program. They can be downloaded from our website, picked up at your local Covenant Church or requested from Covenant Pines.*

> **S.W.E.A.T.** (Service. Worship. Encouragement. Aim. Teamwork.): SWEAT team members help with the daily camp responsibilities as well as special projects. Jobs range from washing dishes, to applying mailing labels, to constructing rock retaining walls. Students will be challenged physically and spiritually as they learn what it means to serve God and one another. One-week session for students entering 9-12th grades.

> **LEADERS IN TRAINING** (LIT): The Leaders In Training program provides an opportunity for students to develop their leadership skills and be challenged to grow in their faith. In this two-week program, students sleep in a cabin, work with a camp counselor building relationships with campers and learning to serve God and others. The first week consists of observing and learning from our Jr. Staff Director, counselors, staff and one another. The second week involves taking on more responsibility and greater leadership by working alongside staff, building relationships and helping lead cabin devotions and group activities. For students entering 10-12th grades.

> **SUPER S.W.E.A.T.** Students join our staff as we travel to Adventurous Christians (AC) on the Gunflint Trail. Once at AC, students will help out with daily responsibilities as well as with special projects, including cutting firewood, clearing trails, washing dishes and other jobs around camp. This 5-day experience will challenge students to grow closer to God through service, fellowship and nature. One-week session for students entering 9-12th grades, as well as recent high school graduates.

> **JR. COUNSELORS** The Jr. Counseling program is for students who desire to lead, serve, and expand on their knowledge of camping ministry, God, service and leadership. One-week session for students entering 11-12th grades and recent graduates; must have completed an LIT session.
