Summer Staff – Job Descriptions

The mission of Adventurous Christians is to provide an environment where people encounter and Experience the Wonder of Christ in creation and in a Christian community.

General Qualifications:

- Must be a committed and joyful follower of Christ.
- Must have a passion for working with youth.
- Must be motivated, hard-working, and servant-hearted.
- Must work well with others and be able to function as a member of a team.
- Must exhibit patience and grace while working with campers & guests.
- All Staff need to be CPR & Basic First Aid Certified.

TRAIL GUIDE

Responsibilities:

- Responsible for preparing and leading a small group of people on a canoe trip through the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness.
 - Groups vary in size from 4-8 and ages vary from youth, families, adult & senior citizens at times.
- Leading devotionals, teaching wilderness skills, teaching creation stewardship and environmental awareness.
- Strive to cultivate an atmosphere of Christian community that will challenge the group to help each other grow spiritually, physically, mentally and emotionally.
- Keep in mind that his/her first priority is the group and their safety.
- Challenge their group spiritually, mentally, and physically.
- Prepare for trips:
 - Pack food, equipment pack, canoes & camping gear
 - Prepare & clean cabins for campers

Qualifications:

- Desire to work with people and share their Christian faith with them.
- Recommended camping experience, though not required.
- Must be minimum 20 years of age, 2 years out of high school.
- Certified in American Red Cross CPR & First Aid and Life Guarding.

KITCHEN SUPERVISOR

Responsibilities:

- Over-all responsibility of a commercial kitchen.
- Keep kitchen area clean at all times and is operated under the health standards of the Minnesota State Board of Health. Includes daily checklists and standards to follow.
- Preparing meals for staff and guests routinely.
- Assists in menu planning.
- Keep inventory, grocery lists, stocking supplies, preparing food and baking.
- In charge of kitchen help/volunteers and is expected to ensure that the guidelines are followed.
- Organizing and responsible for summer trail food preparation.
 - Includes inventory, packing, baking trail food.
- Involved in leading daily devotions and willing to share Christian faith with retreat groups.
- Includes work in other areas of camp when the need arises.

Qualifications:

- Welcoming, inviting, and hospitable
- Desire to serve through the ministry of food
- Good communicator to staff and Directors
- Demonstrate leadership capacity
- Time management, organized
- Able to work long days on foot



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ROVER

Responsibilities:

- Unique position as it requires responsibility in all areas of camp. Includes being:
 - Kitchen Assistant
 - In-Base Assistant
- Involved in leading daily devotions and willing to share Christian faith with camper groups.
- Assists in hosting in-base groups including leading day trips.

Qualifications:

- Willingness to help various tasks at hand.
- Desire to serve.

In-Base

Responsibilities:

- *Summer Program Leader:*
 - Assist Directors in welcoming, announcements, and hosting canoe groups.
 - Assist Directors in coordinating & participating in rhythms of camp summer program.
 - Assisting & supporting Trail Guide's group and trail preparation.
 - Including orientation rotations, route planning, equipment prep, cleaning/prepping lodging, chores/tasks to be completed for hosting/guiding.
 - Oversee the trail room, equipment, & canoe yard.
 - On point for immediate Trail Guide questions (ex. fix equipment, etc.)
 - Involved in leading daily devotions and willing to share Christian faith with camper groups.
- *In-Base Staff:*
 - Assists in hosting/programming in-base groups including leading day trips.
 - Responsible for upkeep and maintenance including: Garbage, recycling, mowing, and grounds keeping (hauling & chopping wood, etc.).
 - Dropping and picking up groups before and after the trips.
 - Preparing the drying fields and sauna before groups return from their canoe trips.
 - Assisting in the kitchen or any other areas of camp as needed.
 - Identify camp needs and take initiative to fix/pick up with Director's approval
- *Trail Guide:*

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PROGRAM DIRECTOR

Responsibilities:

- *Summer Program Leader:*
 - Assist Directors with the implementation of staff training.
 - Assist Directors in welcoming, announcements, and hosting canoe groups.
 - Assist Directors in coordinating & participating in rhythms of camp summer program.
 - Assist Directors with Staff weekly meetings
 - Assisting & supporting Trail Guide's group and trail preparation.
 - Including orientation rotations, route planning, equipment prep, cleaning/prepping lodging, chores/tasks to be completed for hosting/guiding.
 - Oversee the trail room, equipment, & canoe yard.
 - On point for immediate Trail Guide questions (ex. fix equipment, etc.)
 - Involved in leading daily devotions and willing to share Christian faith with camper groups.
- *In-Base Staff:*
 - Assists in hosting/programming in-base groups including leading day trips.
 - Responsible for upkeep and maintenance including: Garbage, recycling, mowing, and grounds keeping (hauling & chopping wood, etc.).
