

COVID-19 Related FAQ Retreat Season

Can I eat a meal in the Dining Hall while at Silver Beach?

No, you will be required to bring all of your own food and beverages for your week at Silver Beach.

What should I do if I want to cancel our time at Silver Beach?

Should you find it necessary to cancel, due to a sick family member, we will refund your deposit or transfer your deposit to another Silver Beach stay. The sooner you are able to notify camp the better.

Will I have to social distance and/or wear a mask while at Silver Beach?

Under the StaySafeMN guidelines, social distancing is recommended outside of a family unit. If social distancing can not be maintained, StaySafeMN recommends requiring a mask when in indoor spaces or when social distancing outside is not possible.

What are the cleaning practices at Silver Beach?

We have upgraded and increased the cleaning practices at Silver Beach in response to COVID19. We will continue to thoroughly clean, disinfect and sanitize your cabin prior to your arrival. We are treating all inside surfaces with OmniShield Protectant, which creates an antimicrobial barrier that ruptures the membrane of any virus or bacteria molecule and kills it. In addition, all outdoor program equipment (playground, docks, boats, lifejackets, lawn furniture....) has also been treated with OmniShield Protectant bringing the same safety benefit. Hand Sanitizer will be available in every cabin and you are encouraged to use it regularly.

What changes will I notice?

- All puzzles and board games have been removed from the cabins to prevent contamination. We encourage you to bring your favorite games and puzzles.
- Covenant Pines Bible Camp has cancelled all Summer Youth camps & all Family Camp. Camp is
 offering Summer Getaways, Thursday-Saturday. This will impact the availability and staffing of Bible
 Camp program offerings.
- The Bath House will be set aside for those camping at Silver Beach.

Will Camp provide bedding and towels like they have in the past?

I'm afraid not. Your family will need to bring pillows, sheets, blankets and towels, dishcloths or sleeping bags (We will provide a fresh bottom sheet on the bed). With the increase in cleaning and a small staff we are not able to provide these things in a safe and healthy way. Below you will find the beds in each of the cabins at Silver Beach so you know what you will need to bring.
