

Group Canoe Trip Rates 2024

4-Nights

Per Person: \$475

5-Nights Per Person: \$500

Preparing Groups:

- Groups spend the first night in-base at AC, the rest are camping out in the Boundary Waters Wilderness Canoe Area Wilderness (BWCAW).
- U.S. Forest Service (USFS) only allows 9 people per group in the BWCAW.
- There is a 4-person minimum to form a group, maximum 8 (the 9th is our AC Guide). If you have more than 8, a new group is formed. We can accommodate up to 5 Groups per week.
- *USFS camper fees (\$8/youth, \$16/adult) and permit reservations (\$10/group) **ARE included** in rates.

Trip Includes:

- All equipment (Duluth packs, tents, canoes, paddles, lifejackets, cooking gear, stoves, etc.)
- All meals/snacks while at camp and on trail
- All US Forest Service camping and permit fees
- Drop off and pickup services to BWCAW entry points
- Lodging accommodations at AC on day of arrival
- AC guide/host/counselor services for entire stay
- Sauna and Celebration Banquet meal returning to AC after canoe trip

<u> Trip Layout:</u>

- All trips begin by arriving at AC mid afternoon on your first day to go thought canoe orientation and prepare for the trip.
- The next morning, groups are dropped off at the boat landing and begin their camping trip.
- Groups spend 3-4 nights on trail before returning to camp.
 - Upon returning to basecamp, groups clean gear, have a sauna and eat a celebration meal before leaving.
 - o Morning pick-up from the BWCAW can plan to depart from AC around 1:00pm
 - Afternoon pick-up from the BWCAW can spend the last evening back at AC doing intentional debrief time with your whole group in the evening and breakfast in the lodge before departing the last morning

Trip Option:

Talk with our guest services director about adding an additional night to the end of your trip for extended intentional debrief time at AC with all of your paddle groups.
