

Counselor job description

- The primary role of the Counselor is to supervise the campers in their care.
- Counselors are responsible to the Program Director.
- Read and study all counselor training materials provided by the camp.
- Prepare spiritually, mentally, and physically for the job.
- During registration, be stationed in your cabin when your campers arrive to welcome them (and their parents). Introduce yourself and help them settle in.
- Be alert to the needs of the campers. Be available for personal connections.
- Have a personal 'one-on-one' with each of your campers to determine where their interests lie and where they are at spiritually. Be on the lookout for opportunities to share your faith with them.
- Follow up with campers by completing post cards for each of them.
- Maintain the discipline of your cabin.
- Know where your campers are. Assure they all make it to all scheduled activities.
- Report any issues to the Head Counselor, Assistant Program Director, or Program Director.
- Cooperate with all other staff members and policies.
- Participate with campers in Cabin Talks, camp games, etc.
- Any other duties or responsibilities as assigned by the Program Director.

Each Day

- Wake up campers with enough time for them to prepare for the day.
- Follow the schedule.
- Supervise and interact with campers throughout the day.
- Lead a devotional, prayer, or bedtime story at night before bed.
- Enforce lights out.
